**COST:** \$175 per semester (0.5 credit) or \$350 for both semesters (1.0 credit) if you are enrolled in a St. Vrain school. For those enrolling from out of district, the cost is \$200 per semester. If tuition assistance is needed, please contact Rachael Ayers directly for more information.

**COURSES:** Students can ONLY enroll in a course that has been taken previously and failed during the regular school year. Courses will be offered only if enrollment reaches a minimum number 15 and courses will be closed once they reach a maximum number of 30. Students can only register for a single course each semester.

**PRE-REGISTRATION:** The best way to pre-register is through your high school counselor. They can discuss the best options with you so that you register for the correct course that best supports your academic goals. The deadline to pre-register through your high school counselor is May 25, 2016. All checks should be made payable to “SVVSD” and sent to Nancy Juth at Sanborn Elementary.

**ONLINE REGISTRATION:** To register online, go to [www.svvsd.org](http://www.svvsd.org) and find the “parents and students” tab at the top of the page. From the drop down menu select “online payments” under General Information. Then select “student academic and athletic fees.” Select “summer school” from the left tool bar. You can register and pay for classes using a credit card any time before summer school starts, up through April 2, 2016.

**LATE REGISTRATION:** A final registration night will be held June 2 from 6:00 – 8:00 pm at Longmont High School. **All students registering on this night will be expected to have a \$75 down payment for each semester they enroll in.** (one semester = \$75 down payment, two semesters = \$150 down payment)

**ATTENDANCE POLICY:** **There are no excused absences or tardies during the Summer School session.** Students must make a commitment to be on time to class and be in attendance every day. Students not in class at the starting time will be marked tardy. Students arriving more than 20 minutes late will be marked absent. Three tardies equals one absence. Parents will be contacted for each absence. A student will be dropped from the summer school session on the third accumulated absence without a refund of tuition fees, and parents will be notified.

**REFUND POLICY:** There will be no tuition reimbursement after classes begin on June 8<sup>th</sup>. Students are expected to have paid for their classes IN FULL by the end of each session.
