<p><b>Overview of Gifted and Talented</b></p>	<p>All identified students are provided with an Advanced Learning Plan that is drafted or updated in the fall each year. This plan documents academic goals, classroom strategies, social emotional goals, and progress monitoring. Parents, teachers and students are valued collaborative partners in ALP development. At Burlington Elementary, all teachers are committed to growth and challenge for all students. We provide differentiated instruction within classrooms to meet individual student needs for across subject areas. Teachers collaborate with the building site leader in development of ALP goals and to develop or enhance their classroom programming strategies and options.</p>

Parents, teachers and students are valued collaborative partners in ALP development.</p> <p>Teachers at Burlington routinely employ a variety of classroom strategies to meet the need of GT students, including Flexible Grouping, Tiered Assignments, Choice-Based Assignments, Varying Levels of Depth and Complexity, Pre-Assessment to Determine Mastery and Curriculum Compacting for students demonstrating mastery.</p> <p>Burlington has participated in collaboration with Sunset MS to offer a 6th Grade Math curriculum for advanced learners.</p> <p>Extracurricular enrichment opportunities have included Club Invention, STEM Explorers, Robotics, Wind Energy, Drama/Musical Theater productions, Choir, Student Council, engineering.</p> <p>Through a USDA Farm to School grant, Burlington students partner with Agriscience and Future Farmers of America to grow and produce food utilized in the school cafeteria. This example of real world application is highly engaging to gifted learners.</p>

<b>Social Emotional Support</b>	Burlington Elementary teachers foster a supportive learning environment by integrating the InFocus curriculum, which provides lessons designed to enhance students' emotional intelligence and resilience. To deepen this impact, educators utilize self-reflection targets that empower students to monitor their own growth and develop vital self-regulation skills. Together, these resources create a consistent, school-wide framework for building a compassionate and mindful classroom community.
